



Dulaney District Cub Scout Day Camp 2010 100 Years of Scouting

Dear Scoutmaster:

Enclosed please find several Youth Crew packets to volunteer at the Dulaney District Cub Scout Day Camp. The theme for this year is **100 Years of Scouting** and will be held again at the Baltimore County Game and Fish Protective Association at 3400 Northwind Road, Baltimore, MD 21234. Your Scouts will have the option to choose one or both of the following two weeks to volunteer at camp: June 21st -25th, 2010 or July 12th-16th, 2010.

The Youth Crew Program has replaced the Den Chief/Den Aide Program in use the past several years. The new program gives the younger Boy Scouts the opportunity to experience more than the Den Aide position they were limited to in the past.

With changes in the past years to our National Accreditation Standards, we are now able to use all Boy Scouts as Youth Crew with a Station. Youth crew will only be assigned as to a den at the request of a den leader and only if we have enough youth to staff the stations. The Youth Crew Chief will place the boys based on their preference on the application combined with his assessment of the boys' scouting experience and ability to handle the responsibilities of assisting at a Station.

SCOUTMASTERS: THE YOUTH CREW CHIEF MAY CONTACT YOU TO DISCUSS SOME OF YOUR SCOUTS TO ASSIST IN HIS DETERMINATION IN THEIR PLACEMENT.

Time is of the essence with the information enclosed in this packet. We are limiting our youth crew size to a maximum of 50 volunteers each session.

To register, a Scout needs to complete the enclosed Youth Crew Application, a Medical Form, and the Dulaney District Family Tally Sheet. If the Scout has a sibling or adult that will also be assisting at our Day Camp, please instruct them to complete the Tally Sheet with all information pertaining to that family and submit ONE check made payable to BSA/BAC. While Cub Scout applications will only be accepted in February and March 2010, Youth Crew Applications can be submitted at any time. The sooner, the better so we can properly assign positions. We ask that all Youth Crew Applications be received by June 1st, 2010.

Applications are not to be sent to the council office. Please advise interested parents to send **completed** applications in order to expedite registration for your Scout. As mentioned above, ONE check should be submitted attached to the Family Tally Sheet. This year, the Baltimore Area Council is requiring us to submit all checks with this form so that they may verify that all Scouts and Leaders (as applicable) are registered. Including the Family Tally Sheet, attach forms in the following order:

- Family Tally Sheet (totaled with ONE check attached)
- Youth Crew Application Form(s) (with completed Medical Form(s))
