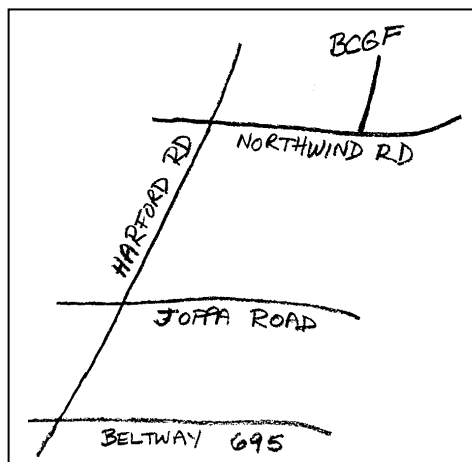
Who: Any registered Cub Scout who is entering the 1st, 2nd, 3rd, 4th, or 5th grade. and their parents/guardians.

When: June 18 – 22, 2012 7:45 a.m. - 4:20 p.m. daily Camp begins at 8:00 a.m. sharp!
July 9 13, 2012 7:45 a.m. - 4:20 p.m. daily Camp begins at 8:00 a.m. sharp!
(*LATE PICK-UP POLICY: after 4:30pm, there will be a charge of \$10.00 for every 5 minutes. This applies every day including Wednesday. Payment accepted at the time of pick-up in cash or by check payable to BAC/BSA.*)

Where: Baltimore County Game and Fish Protective Association

Directions: From the Beltway (695), take Harford Road going North (approx. 2 miles), turn right on Northwind Road and go approx. 0.6 miles to the camp on your left.

All volunteers must park in the BGE field beyond BBs (see attached map). Those dropping off Scouts may proceed down the driveway.



Cost: The base price for the camp is \$150 and includes a Cub Scout Day Camp T-shirt, a patch, a hat, crafts, and expendable program supplies. Discounts are granted to parents who volunteer to help. See your Pack Coordinator for details. **Once program materials and T-shirts have been ordered, NO REFUNDS can be made since operating expenses have already been incurred.**

How: We offer a planned Cub Scout Day Camp program packed with fun-filled activities including Scout Skills, Fishing, Nature, Games and more. There is a special Wednesday campfire for parents and lots of FUN.

Registration: Camp registration is limited. To enroll your child, complete the Application and Family Summary Sheet, attach a check for the entire family payable to BSA/BAC and turn in to your **PACK COORDINATOR** or contact your Cubmaster or write daycamp@dulaneybsa.org for further instructions.

Do not mail your application anywhere until instructed to do so—do not take the application to the Council Service Center or the Help Desk at the Scout Shop.
